### **President's Welcome/Introductions**

Dottie Gottfried opened the meeting at 7:10 PM. Dottie reported Maggie Dyer (Girls Basketball Coach) will be running a Girls Basketball Camp at Wootton for 3 weeks this summer. She will be using the school store during that time. The income earned from the camp will go to the Girls Basketball account. May 15 is also the Community Day for Girls Basketball. The idea of having an ice machine outside closer to the stadium is tabled until the fall. The Booster Club is trying to make the schedule of events available for teams to view, this way teams will know when they can and can't schedule events. The Booster Club will also try to coordinate events with all fall teams and all spring teams together.
